This Privacy Policy explains how **Corrine’s Creations DBA Curations, Curations Kitchen, and Curated Experiences** (“**Company**”) collects, uses, discloses, and safeguards information when you use our website(s), contact us, book events, visit our venue, or otherwise engage with our services (collectively, the “**Services**”).

1) Scope

This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect:

- Through our website(s) and online booking or inquiry forms at **www.curations.events** (the “**Site**”);
- When you tour, book, plan, host, attend, or participate in an event at our venue(s);
- Through contracts, invoices, payments, communications, and customer support.

It does not apply to third-party websites, payment processors, ticketing platforms, or social media platforms that may link to or integrate with our Services.

2) Information We Collect

We collect information in three main ways: (a) information you provide, (b) information collected automatically, and (c) information from third parties.

A. Information You Provide

Depending on how you engage with us, you may provide:

Booking & Client Information

- Name, email, phone number, address
- Organization name (if applicable), role/title
- Event type (wedding, corporate event, nonprofit gala, etc.), dates/times, estimated guest count

- Planning details (layout preferences, schedules, vendor plans, staffing needs)

Event Attendee-Related Information (as provided by the client/host)

- Guest lists and RSVP details (names and contact information, if provided)
- Seating charts, plus-one details, meal selections, dietary restrictions, allergies
- Accessibility needs and accommodation requests

Note: dietary restrictions, allergies, and accessibility needs may be considered sensitive in certain contexts; we ask that clients only provide what is necessary for event execution.

Vendor / Contractor Information

- Vendor contacts and business information (caterers, DJs, photographers, security, rentals)
- Insurance certificates and compliance documentation (as required by contract/policy)

Transactions and Contracting

- Signed contracts, deposits, invoices, refund records
- Billing address and payment confirmations
- Limited payment details (see Section 6)

Communications

- Emails, texts, phone call notes, chat messages, and support requests
- Photos, documents, or files you choose to share for planning purposes

B. Information Collected Automatically

When you visit the Site or interact with our online content, we may collect:

- IP address, browser type, device identifiers, operating system
- Pages viewed, clicks, referral URLs, and approximate location (via IP)
- Cookies and similar technologies (see Section 7)

C. Information From Third Parties

We may receive information from:

- **Payment processors** (transaction confirmations, tokenized identifiers, fraud signals)
- **Ticketing/RSVP platforms** (if used) as authorized by you or the event host
- **Marketing and analytics providers** (Site performance data)
- **Social media platforms** (if you interact with our pages or ads)

- **Event hosts** (when a host provides attendee lists or planning details)

3) How We Use Information

We use information to:

- Respond to inquiries, provide quotes, schedule tours, and manage bookings
- Draft and administer contracts, invoices, deposits, and refunds
- Plan and execute events, including vendor coordination and venue operations
- Provide customer service and communicate about your event (logistics, changes, requirements)
- Improve our Services, Site performance, and customer experience
- Maintain safety, security, and fraud prevention
- Comply with legal obligations, enforce contract terms, and resolve disputes
- Send marketing communications (where permitted), and you may opt out (Section 8)

4) Photography, Video, and Event Recordings

- **Public/common-area recording:** We may use cameras in common areas for safety and security. Where required, we will post signage.
- **Event photography/videography:** Events may involve third-party photographers/videographers hired by clients/hosts. Those vendors control their own privacy practices.
- **Company marketing use:** With your permission (or as agreed in your contract), we may use event photos/videos for marketing (e.g., website, social media).
 - If you want to opt out of marketing use of identifiable images for your event, contact us at info@curations.events and/or ensure your contract reflects that preference.
- **User-generated content:** If you tag us or post content publicly, we may reshare it consistent with the platform's settings and our practices.

5) How We Disclose Information

We may disclose information to:

Service Providers

- Website hosting, scheduling tools, CRM systems, analytics providers
- Email/SMS communication providers

- Payment processors and fraud-prevention vendors
- Accounting, legal, and professional advisors

Event Operations (as needed)

- Staff and contractors supporting your event
- Vendors you direct us to coordinate with (or vendors engaged through us, if applicable)
- Security providers or onsite support personnel as required for the event

Legal / Safety

We may disclose information if required by law or if we believe disclosure is necessary to protect rights, safety, prevent fraud, or enforce agreements.

Business Transfers

If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, or sale of assets, information may be transferred as part of that transaction.

6) Payments, Credit Cards, and Financial Information

We take payment security seriously.

- **Payment processing:** We use third-party payment processors to process credit/debit card transactions and other payment methods.
- **Card data storage:** We generally do **not** store full credit card numbers. Payment information is transmitted to our processor and may be tokenized. We may retain limited information such as card brand and last four digits, along with transaction IDs, for accounting, disputes, and refunds.
- **Billing and records:** We retain invoices, payment confirmations, and related records as required for business and tax purposes.

7) Cookies and Similar Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- Provide core website functionality and security
- Remember preferences
- Understand Site usage and improve performance
- Measure the effectiveness of advertising (if enabled)

You can manage cookies through your browser settings. Disabling cookies may affect site functionality.

8) Your Choices

You may be able to:

- **Opt out of marketing emails** by using the unsubscribe link or contacting us
- **Opt out of marketing texts** by replying STOP (if applicable) or contacting us
- **Request access, correction, or deletion** of certain personal information (Section 12)
- **Limit what you provide:** If you are an event host, please avoid providing unnecessary sensitive details about attendees

9) Data Retention

We keep information as long as reasonably necessary to:

- Perform our Services and manage bookings and events
- Maintain business records (accounting, audits, tax)
- Comply with legal obligations
- Resolve disputes and enforce contracts

Retention varies by information type and business need.

10) Data Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect information. No method of transmission or storage is completely secure, so we cannot guarantee absolute security.

11) Children's Privacy

Our Services are not directed to children, and we do not knowingly collect personal information directly from children online. If you believe a child has provided personal information directly to us through the Site, contact us so we can address it.
